So it is participant NW3. So the first question is how, were you feeling as you did that, giving that dose?

I felt a little bit apprehensive just checking that, I was happy with making up the solution, just giving the right amount and diluting it to the right amount as well, I was yeah a bit concerned about that

Ok

Because I didn't feel, I think having something to go by like a guide or an equation or something is does help me, so I was a little bit, a little bit anxious about that

Ok, so there were a couple of things that I noticed that were kind of different to what I expected. So one was that I think you used 17mls of saline to dilute the powder, is that

Should have been 16, 16?

16 ok

I went a bit over didn't I?

Well I was expecting it to be 9 and a half

Oh

So I just wondered if you can talk me through your, your thinking as you made the decision as to how much to use

Because I used... I went totally off piste with that then, because I diluted it, 20... because I diluted 40, 40 to 1, where did I, hang on... I think I have just taken off the 4 mls to make it 360

Right

But now I can't see how I have made it up to 20 mls because it is...

So what were you trying to make? Was there a certain concentration you were aiming for?

Well just the 360 from 400 and I have just taken away the 4 mls but I don't, obviously it is not 20 mls the 400 of the medication.

Yep

I don't even know where I have got that from now. Yeah totally off piste with that one.

And the other thing we talked about it, well you talked to me at the time when you were doing it, you decided to give it over one hour and you were looking at the top here where it says give over one to three hours, the thing is that the maximum rate given how much the patient weighed would then be two hours, because they are 60 kilos, so if you could talk me through what you were thinking when you did that.

Just because it says 400, because this for giving 400 over, 400 and it is not over because it was under 400 and it was one to three hours, I just thought that that is 3 milligrams per kg, I didn't even know I was looking at the weight to be honest, I thought it was just more about drawing up the medication

Yeah

Not the whole thing of it, but obviously that would have been taken into consideration umm which I am sure is what I did before you know as well on this, on the weight there was something else on there. Yeah didn't, didn't factor into the weight at all this, I just looked at this, the one to three

OK. And lots of people get confused by that bit so don't worry

One to three and I just presumed because it was a lower side of the dose the one hour would be suitable, as opposed to if you were giving a bigger dose of it you would want to slow it down

Do you think those two little mistakes were related to the information on the page in any way?

Umm... partly could be and partly me I think yeah but umm

And is there anything

It is quite wordy to be honest to get your head around it and what you are actually diluting to. I have found drawing up medication a bit more straightforward than that before than what I have been reading from there, like I say because it is quite wordy where as you have just got fixed sort of numbers and solutions and dilutions but yeah possibly yeah

Anything we could change about it to kind of stop that kind of thing from happening?

Umm maybe an example on there of what you are looking for
